



## 2018 Congressional Questionnaire

1. **Raising the Wage:** Do you support the “Fight for \$15” movement and a national minimum wage of at least \$15/hour?
  1. Yes, there is not a state in the union where you can afford a two bedroom apartment on less than \$15/hr. Who lives in two bedroom apartments? Young families who aren’t ready to buy a house - single parents - the conversation starts at \$15 and not lower.
  
2. **Climate Justice:** As a member of Congress, would you sign on to – and organize more support for – HR 3671, the Off Fossil Fuels Act?

4. **Fair Economy:** Do you support the Robin Hood Tax that would tax Wall Street financial transactions to raise billions of dollars in much-needed revenue and rein in the abusive practices on Wall Street?
  1. I agree with one of my endorser’s, Senator Bernie Sanders. Our economy is rigged in favor of Wall Street, big businesses, and the wealthiest Americans. I support the Robin Hood Tax to end abusive practices on Wall Street and create an economy where working families are able to win the future.
